Announcing admissions for the 2nd Batch of a one-of-a-kind PGCDS (PG Certificate in **Dryland Studies) Program** conducted by Professors, Scientists and Experts from the **Ben** Gurion University of the Negev, Israel (BGU) - https://in.bgu.ac.il/en/bidr/Pages/default.aspx

The Certificate is offered by BGU, Israel. The On-Campus & Off Campus Certificate Program is being conducted respectively in ABIDAT, Chennai or via fully 'On-line mode'. For the On-Campus program Students (including <u>In-Service Candidates</u>) are required to be in Chennai for the duration of the 2 (two) semesters Certificate Program. Students opting for the 'Off Campus' (fully 'On-line mode') can attend classes online from anywhere, however they will be required to participate in the Internship program physically in Tamil Nadu &/or any place the same is scheduled, in partial fulfillment of the requirements of the PGCDS program. Participation in Trialscum-Exercises during the Summer Break between the 2 Semesters &/or at the end of 2nd Semester will entitle Students to an additional Certificate.

WHO CAN APPLY FOR THE GOLDEN OPPORTUNITY?

Students who possess degrees (UG & above) in Agriculture & allied disciplines (including Horticulture, Forestry, Animal Husbandry, Dairy, Agricultural Engineering, Water Technology, etc); besides, graduates in Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Biotechnology and allied Life Sciences, with a minimum of 50% Aggregate Score. Applicants expecting to complete their graduation by 2023 are eligible.

Besides, those who are "In-Service Employees" in various public and private sector organisations involved in Agriculture and allied fields, are also encouraged to apply.

WHY APPLY FOR THIS PROGRAM?

The PGCDS program will benefit all those interested to learn in-depth multidisciplinary approaches to dryland ecosystems management, including rainfed, semi-arid, arid ecologies and allied ecosystems. Credits earned in the program will be considered as a partial fulfillment for future studies in obtaining a M.Sc. degree in Desert Studies offered by the Albert Katz International School for Desert Studies (https://in.bgu.ac.il/en/akis/Pages/default.aspx) in the Jacob Blaustein Institutes for Desert Research (BIDR) at Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, Israel, with a possibility of grant of Fellowship (Benefits equivalent to INR 1.0 Lac per Month for upto 2 Years), as obtained by 100% of the 1st Batch (2022-<mark>23)</mark>.

Candidates will then be required to undertake an online examination (**OET**) from the comfort of their homes on the stipulated **time and date**. The performance in the OET will rank the candidates for selection. 'Counseling-cum-Interview', and screening according to Merit will lead to the final selection, enrolment
